- Training is being imparted to faculty in a progressive manner on computer assisted teaching and usage of apps as teaching tools.
- Plans to procure virtual software and LMS tools to enable enhanced convenience in ICT mode of teaching are underway.
- Enhanced Academia-Industry partnerships are pursued through MOUs, internships, hands-on training, and student projects in and outside the college, technical trainings at well-equipped sophisticated labs of the Science Department.
