### 7.3.1. Portray the performance of the Institution in one area distinctive to its priority and thrust

#### National Cadet Corps (NCC)

The National Cadet Corps (NCC) is a youth organization in India that aims to develop character, leadership, discipline, and a sense of service among young citizens. The main motto of NCC is "Unity in Discipline". Our college has one NCC Unit with 108 vacancies which works under 17 Andhra Battalion, Vijayawada. NCC unit is under the control of ANO / Care taker appointed by Principal of the college and approved by Commanding officer, 17 Andhra Battalion, Vijayawada. Since its inception in the college NCC is playing a crucial role in grooming young minds with the noble objective of nation building. Obviously our NCC unit is a distinctive feature of our college.

Every year the enrolment of students in NCC has increased and admission of girl students reached its target in 2022-23. At present there are 40 girl cadets and 68 boys in NCC. On every Thursday and Friday morning Physical Training and Drill periods are carried out in the college ground. The Associate NCC Officer (ANO) and Permanent Instructional Staff jointly take the theoretical classes on every Thursday both for Common subjects and specialized subjects of DGNCC syllabus. During these five years there are 155 B- certificate holders and 65 Cadets with C certificate. NCC 'C' certification is beneficial to the students in employment and Higher education as it offers 10-15 bonus marks. About 25 cadets are employed and 20 members are in higher education. The distinctiveness of NCC is reflected by securing Bronze medal in firing by B.Himaja of II MPCs in N.C.C Talsainik Inter Group Competition Camp at Tirupati in August 23 and winning Silver medal at Talsainik Camp at New Delhi in the month of October 2023.
