In the current Academic Year 1,298 students which includes 1,106 in Graduate Courses and 192 in Post-Graduate Courses are receiving Value-Based Education with 65 teaching faculty and 35 non-teaching staff. I am happy to bring to attention that most of our students are from rural areas whose parents are small and marginal farmers and down trodden members of the society which includes SC, ST, BC and Minority communities. The state and central government have dispersed scholarships to the students for this academic year. 1232 students received Rs.10,000/each through Jaganna Vidya Deevena(JVD) Scheme, some of the students have received JVD Cards from our honourable M.L.A Sri Kolusu Partha Saradhi in our College Auditorium. Our students were getting financial support from various charitable organizations and philanthropists as well.

On this occasion, I request the Honorable M.L.A to request the government to release the Fee Reimbursement amount as early as possible.

RUSA AND UGC SUPPORTED DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES

In this Academic Year, Rs.2 crores has been sanctioned by RUSA for the development activities in the college. Rs.1 crore has been released in 1st phase and the amount of Rs.60,00,000/- has been spent for the construction of 3 Virtual Class Rooms, 1 Digital Class Room, 1 E-Class Management System Room, 1 Computer Lab and Rs.8 lakhs has been spent for the purchase of new equipment in the Physics and Chemistry Departments. Moreover the remaining 40 lakhs along with the Management funds Rs.42 lakhs has been spent for the construction of 5 class rooms and 1 computer lab. On behalf of our students my special thanks goes to our Secretary Sri Paladugu Lakshmana Rao, for taking special interest in this matter. RUSA Special Grant Rs.1 crore has to be released in 2nd phase for the construction of new building. Along with this amount Siddhartha Academy also sponsored Rs.1 crore for the construction of G+2 basement level. The construction is under process. Rs.5 crores has been spent so far for the construction of new buildings and other development activities. Once again, my sincere thanks go to our Secretary for his efforts.

The College Management is going to implement CC Camera and Bio-Metric System in this Academic Year.

University Grants Commission (UGC) has released the 12th 5-year plan due amount of Rs.6,00,000/- for the construction of Outdoor Stadium and the amount has been spent. Rs.20 lakhs have been released under Autonomous Funds.

EXAMS WING

- Mr. M.VenuGopal, as Controller of Examinations, Mr.N.V.Srinivasa rao and Mr.K.Ramesh as Additional Controller of Examinations are discharging their duties with lot of responsibility.
- It is the eighth year since we got autonomous status for our college. In the VI semester examinations held in March, 2019 we achieved a pass percentage of 86% in B.A, 89% in B.Com and 87% in B.Sc.
- The semester exams held in 2019 October and 38 students of 1st B.Sc, 10 students of 2nd B.Sc, 12 students of 3rd B.Sc all together 60 students have scored 100% marks in mathematics. 4 students from 1st year, 1 student from Second Year and 10 students from III year altogether 15 students have score 100% marks in Chemistry.
