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## **I. Introduction**

The Office of the Controller of Examinations was established in accordance to the UGC Regulations for Autonomous Institutions in the year 2012 after the college was conferred the autonomy status. The institution is also affiliated to the Krishna University and adheres to the norms prescribed by the University relating to Choice Based Credit System, (CBCS), the computation of Grade Point Average, (GPA), Cumulative Grade Point Average, (CGPA), and the ten point Grading Scale. The CBCS was adopted in 2015 since autonomy. The Degree is awarded by the Krishna University on completion of the academic programme.

The 'autonomous' status grants the Institution a considerable degree of flexibility with regard to the introduction of new courses, Value added courses, Diploma courses, revision of existing courses through enrichment of the curriculum, methodology of evaluation which are exercised after being approved by the Board of Studies and the Academic council.

### **Conduct of Board of Studies, Academic Council, Finance Committee and Governing Body Meetings:**

Each department constitutes the Board of Studies as per the UGC regulations for Autonomous Institutions. Regular Meetings of the Academic Council, Finance Committee and Governing Body are held every year.

### **MISSION:**

To ensure quality sustenance in the evaluation process imbibing the principles of transparency, validity, accountability, timeliness, efficiency and effectiveness contributing to the attainment of the mission and vision of the College.

### **The key functions of the COE office covers the following areas.**

**a. Examinations:** After the Board of Studies and Academic Council meetings, the list of courses along with the syllabus is forwarded to the departments. Course codes are framed for new courses for the preparation of the subject matter. Communications are sent to the External examiners for Question paper setting. Time-table for examinations are communicated and condonation list, Hall-tickets, Attendance sheets and all other examination related documents are generated through SPSR Software. Valuation and Examination Passing procedure is also planned.

**b. Data Entry:** The COE staffs maintain the soft copies of student data, right from entry level until completion of the course. They compile, verify and maintain the student data programme wise for each year. The relevant data of the outgoing batches is forwarded to the Krishna University as a Hard copy. The graduate list and the Rank list for UG and PG is prepared by the COE office every year. The Provisional Certificate is issued by the Krishna University The Degree Certificates are verified and collected from Krishna University to be issued to candidates. This office works along with an external partnering software agency, (SPRS 2013), for all software applications and automation.



**c. Record Maintenance and Verification:** Student academic records since 2012 are maintained in the form of hard bound registers. Applications relating to student verification are attended to by the COE staff by physically verifying the student data with the records. Transcripts are issued to students for their higher education abroad after proper verification of the student's records.

**d. Finance Section:** Proper records are maintained for the Honorarium and remuneration paid for all examination related services.

**e. Student Grievance and Enquiry Section:** Students not satisfied with their examination score can apply for revaluation within a period of 10 days from the date of declaration of results. Current and previous batch students submit their request/application/queries at the COE office which would be addressed by the COE office within a reasonable time.

**f. Storage and Disposal:** Answer scripts of students are preserved for three years and later disposed to UPS (Universal Print Systems) along with other used papers under Wellbeing Out of Waste (WOW), a National Recycling initiative taking into account eco-friendly practices.

The college offers 10 UG and 3 PG academic programmes. The prime responsibility of planning and conducting both Continuous Internal Assessment and End Semester Examinations for all UG and PG academic programmes is executed by the COE office in a centralised, systematic and transparent manner. Examinations are planned as per the academic calendar released in the beginning of the academic year. The COE reports to Principal and is assisted by the Additional Controller of Examinations and Support staff. The COE office is fully automated and is provided with the necessary infrastructure for its effective functioning.

The COE prepares the schedule of Examinations which are communicated to the Heads of the Department and students through Institutional email ids, whats app groups and website. The annual report provides a comprehensive overview of the activities of the COE office.

## **2. Initiative Drive:**

More changes have occurred around new guidelines relating to conducting examinations based on UGC Academic reforms in Higher Education Institutions, Outcome based education and Bloom's Taxonomy was implemented. The Departments framed their programme outcomes and course outcomes in tandem with the Institutional outcomes and the same are approved in the respective Board of Studies meeting. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) organised orientation programmes for faculty members to measure the PO's / CO's. Internal valuation and end semester examinations are structured around the attainment of the PO / CO.

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## **1. Introduction**

The Office of the Controller of Examinations was established in accordance to the UGC Regulations for Autonomous Institutions in the year 2012 after the college was conferred the autonomy status. The institution is also affiliated to the Krishna University and adheres to the norms prescribed by the University relating to Choice Based Credit System, (CBCS), the computation of Grade Point Average, (GPA), Cumulative Grade Point Average, (CGPA), and the ten point Grading Scale. The CBCS was adopted in 2015 since autonomy. The Degree is awarded by the Krishna University on completion of the academic programme.

The 'autonomous' status grants the Institution a considerable degree of flexibility with regard to the introduction of new courses, Value added courses, Diploma courses, revision of existing courses through enrichment of the curriculum, methodology of evaluation which are exercised after being approved by the Board of Studies and the Academic council.

### **Conduct of Board of Studies, Academic Council, Finance Committee and Governing Body Meetings:**

Each department constitutes the Board of Studies as per the UGC regulations for Autonomous Institutions. Regular Meetings of the Academic Council, Finance Committee and Governing Body are held every year.

### **MISSION:**

To ensure quality sustenance in the evaluation process imbibing the principles of transparency, validity, accountability, timeliness, efficiency and effectiveness contributing to the attainment of the mission and vision of the College.

### **The key functions of the COE office covers the following areas.**

**a. Examinations:** After the Board of Studies and Academic Council meetings, the list of courses along with the syllabus is forwarded to the departments. Course codes are framed for new courses for the preparation of the subject matter. Communications are sent to the External examiners for Question paper setting. Time-table for examinations are communicated and condonation list, Hall-tickets, Attendance sheets and all other examination related documents are generated through SPSR Software. Valuation and Examination Passing procedure is also planned.

**b. Data Entry:** The COE staffs maintain the soft copies of student data, right from entry level until completion of the course. They compile, verify and maintain the student data programme wise for each year. The relevant data of the outgoing batches is forwarded to the Krishna University as a Hard copy. The graduate list and the Rank list for UG and PG is prepared by the COE office every year. The Provisional Certificate is issued by the Krishna University The Degree Certificates are verified and collected from Krishna University to be issued to candidates. This office works along with an external partnering software agency, (SPRS 2013), for all software applications and automation.

**c. Record Maintenance and Verification:** Student academic records since 2012 are maintained in the form of hard bound registers. Applications relating to student verification are attended to by the COE staff by physically verifying the student data with the records. Transcripts are issued to students for their higher education abroad after proper verification of the student's records.

**d. Finance Section:** Proper records are maintained for the Honorarium and remuneration paid for all examination related services.

**e. Student Grievance and Enquiry Section:** Students not satisfied with their examination score can apply for revaluation within a period of 10 days from the date of declaration of results. Current and previous batch students submit their request/application/queries at the COE office which would be addressed by the COE office within a reasonable time.

**f. Storage and Disposal:** Answer scripts of students are preserved for three years and later disposed to UPS (Universal Print Systems) along with other used papers under Wellbeing Out of Waste (WOW), a National Recycling initiative taking into account eco-friendly practices.

The college offers 10 UG and 3 PG academic programmes. The prime responsibility of planning and conducting both Continuous Internal Assessment and End Semester Examinations for all UG and PG academic programmes is executed by the COE office in a centralised, systematic and transparent manner. Examinations are planned as per the academic calendar released in the beginning of the academic year. The COE reports to Principal and is assisted by the Additional Controller of Examinations and Support staff. The COE office is fully automated and is provided with the necessary infrastructure for its effective functioning.

The COE prepares the schedule of Examinations which are communicated to the Heads of the Department and students through Institutional email ids, whats app groups and website. The annual report provides a comprehensive overview of the activities of the COE office.

The Office of the COE remained vigilant towards the risks and challenges stemming from the pandemic Covid-19 and in response all examinations were held as per standard guidelines. Valuation of answer scripts were done by External for UG students. Both external and internal valuation is done for PG students. COE office takes the earnest efforts in the interest of the students and remains committed to extend all kinds of support to students.

## **2. Initiative Drive:**

Several initiatives were launched as the situation of Covid-19 pandemic required continuous focussed attention. More changes have occurred around new guidelines relating to conducting examinations based on UGC Academic reforms in Higher Education Institutions, Outcome based education and Bloom's Taxonomy was implemented. The Departments framed their programme outcomes and course outcomes in tandem with the Institutional outcomes and the same are approved in the respective Board of Studies meeting. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) organised orientation programmes for faculty members to measure the PO's / CO's. Internal valuation and end semester examinations are structured around the attainment of the PO / CO.

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## **1. Introduction**

The Office of the Controller of Examinations was established in accordance to the UGC Regulations for Autonomous Institutions in the year 2012 after the college was conferred the autonomy status. The institution is also affiliated to the Krishna University and adheres to the norms prescribed by the University relating to Choice Based Credit System, (CBCS), the computation of Grade Point Average, (GPA), Cumulative Grade Point Average, (CGPA), and the ten point Grading Scale. The CBCS was adopted in 2015 since autonomy. The Degree is awarded by the Krishna University on completion of the academic programme.

The 'autonomous' status grants the Institution a considerable degree of flexibility with regard to the introduction of new courses, Value added courses, Diploma courses, revision of existing courses through enrichment of the curriculum, methodology of evaluation which are exercised after being approved by the Board of Studies and the Academic council.

### **Conduct of Board of Studies, Academic Council, Finance Committee and Governing Body Meetings:**

Each department constitutes the Board of Studies as per the UGC regulations for Autonomous Institutions. Regular Meetings of the Academic Council, Finance Committee and Governing Body are held every year.

### **MISSION:**

To ensure quality sustenance in the evaluation process imbibing the principles of transparency, validity, accountability, timeliness, efficiency and effectiveness contributing to the attainment of the mission and vision of the College.

### **The key functions of the COE office covers the following areas.**

**a. Examinations:** After the Board of Studies and Academic Council meetings, the list of courses along with the syllabus is forwarded to the departments. Course codes are framed for new courses for the preparation of the subject matter. Communications are sent to the External examiners for Question paper setting. Time-table for examinations are communicated and condonation list, Hall-tickets, Attendance sheets and all other examination related documents are generated through SPSR Software. Valuation and Examination Passing procedure is also planned.

**b. Data Entry:** The COE staffs maintain the soft copies of student data, right from entry level until completion of the course. They compile, verify and maintain the student data programme wise for each year. The relevant data of the outgoing batches is forwarded to the Krishna University as a Hard copy. The graduate list and the Rank list for UG and PG is prepared by the COE office every year. The Provisional Certificate is issued by the Krishna University The Degree Certificates are verified and collected from Krishna University to be issued to candidates. This office works along with an external partnering software agency, (SPRS 2013), for all software applications and automation.

**c. Record Maintenance and Verification:** Student academic records since 2012 are maintained in the form of hard bound registers. Applications relating to student verification are attended to by the COE staff by physically verifying the student data with the records. Transcripts are issued to students for their higher education abroad after proper verification of the student's records.

**d. Finance Section:** Proper records are maintained for the Honorarium and remuneration paid for all examination related services.

**e. Student Grievance and Enquiry Section:** Students not satisfied with their examination score can apply for revaluation within a period of 10 days from the date of declaration of results. Current and previous batch students submit their request/application/queries at the COE office which would be addressed by the COE office within a reasonable time.

**f. Storage and Disposal:** Answer scripts of students are preserved for three years and later disposed to UPS (Universal Print Systems) along with other used papers under Wellbeing Out of Waste (WOW), a National Recycling initiative taking into account eco-friendly practices.

The college offers 10 UG and 3 PG academic programmes. The prime responsibility of planning and conducting both Continuous Internal Assessment and End Semester Examinations for all UG and PG academic programmes is executed by the COE office in a centralised, systematic and transparent manner. Examinations are planned as per the academic calendar released in the beginning of the academic year. The COE reports to Principal and is assisted by the Additional Controller of Examinations and Support staff. The COE office is fully automated and is provided with the necessary infrastructure for its effective functioning.

The COE prepares the schedule of Examinations which are communicated to the Heads of the Department and students through Institutional email ids, whats app groups and website. The annual report provides a comprehensive overview of the activities of the COE office.

The Office of the COE remained vigilant towards the risks and challenges stemming from the pandemic Covid-19 and in response all examinations were held as per standard guidelines. Valuation of answer scripts were done by External for UG students. Both external and internal valuation is done for PG students. COE office takes the earnest efforts in the interest of the students and remains committed to extend all kinds of support to students.

## **2. Initiative Drive:**

Several initiatives were launched as the situation of Covid-19 pandemic required continuous focussed attention. More changes have occurred around new guidelines relating to conducting examinations based on UGC Academic reforms in Higher Education Institutions, Outcome based education and Bloom's Taxonomy was implemented. The Departments framed their programme outcomes and course outcomes in tandem with the Institutional outcomes and the same are approved in the respective Board of Studies meeting. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) organised orientation programmes for faculty members to measure the PO's / CO's. Internal valuation and end semester examinations are structured around the attainment of the PO / CO.

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## **1. Introduction**

The Office of the Controller of Examinations was established in accordance to the UGC Regulations for Autonomous Institutions in the year 2012 after the college was conferred the autonomy status. The institution is also affiliated to the Krishna University and adheres to the norms prescribed by the University relating to Choice Based Credit System, (CBCS), the computation of Grade Point Average, (GPA), Cumulative Grade Point Average, (CGPA), and the ten point Grading Scale. The CBCS was adopted in 2015 since autonomy. The Degree is awarded by the Krishna University on completion of the academic programme.

The 'autonomous' status grants the Institution a considerable degree of flexibility with regard to the introduction of new courses, Value added courses, Diploma courses, revision of existing courses through enrichment of the curriculum, methodology of evaluation which are exercised after being approved by the Board of Studies and the Academic council.

### **Conduct of Board of Studies, Academic Council, Finance Committee and Governing Body Meetings:**

Each department constitutes the Board of Studies as per the UGC regulations for Autonomous Institutions. Regular Meetings of the Academic Council, Finance Committee and Governing Body are held every year.

### **MISSION:**

To ensure quality sustenance in the evaluation process imbibing the principles of transparency, validity, accountability, timeliness, efficiency and effectiveness contributing to the attainment of the mission and vision of the College.

### **The key functions of the COE office covers the following areas.**

**a. Examinations:** After the Board of Studies and Academic Council meetings, the list of courses along with the syllabus is forwarded to the departments. Course codes are framed for new courses for the preparation of the subject matter. Communications are sent to the External examiners for Question paper setting. Time-table for examinations are communicated and condonation list, Hall-tickets, Attendance sheets and all other examination related documents are generated through SPSR Software. Valuation and Examination Passing procedure is also planned.

**b. Data Entry:** The COE staffs maintain the soft copies of student data, right from entry level until completion of the course. They compile, verify and maintain the student data programme wise for each year. The relevant data of the outgoing batches is forwarded to the Krishna University as a Hard copy. The graduate list and the Rank list for UG and PG is prepared by the COE office every year. The Provisional Certificate is issued by the Krishna University The Degree Certificates are verified and collected from Krishna University to be issued to candidates. This office works along with an external partnering software agency, (SPRS 2013), for all software applications and automation.

**c. Record Maintenance and Verification:** Student academic records since 2012 are maintained in the form of hard bound registers. Applications relating to student verification are attended to by the COE staff by physically verifying the student data with the records. Transcripts are issued to students for their higher education abroad after proper verification of the student's records.

**d. Finance Section:** Proper records are maintained for the Honorarium and remuneration paid for all examination related services.

**e. Student Grievance and Enquiry Section:** Students not satisfied with their examination score can apply for revaluation within a period of 10 days from the date of declaration of results. Current and previous batch students submit their request/application/queries at the COE office which would be addressed by the COE office within a reasonable time.

**f. Storage and Disposal:** Answer scripts of students are preserved for three years and later disposed to UPS (Universal Print Systems) along with other used papers under Wellbeing Out of Waste (WOW), a National Recycling initiative taking into account eco-friendly practices.

The college offers 10 UG and 3 PG academic programmes. The prime responsibility of planning and conducting both Continuous Internal Assessment and End Semester Examinations for all UG and PG academic programmes is executed by the COE office in a centralised, systematic and transparent manner. Examinations are planned as per the academic calendar released in the beginning of the academic year. The COE reports to Principal and is assisted by the Additional Controller of Examinations and Support staff. The COE office is fully automated and is provided with the necessary infrastructure for its effective functioning.

The COE prepares the schedule of Examinations which are communicated to the Heads of the Department and students through Institutional email ids, whats app groups and website. The annual report provides a comprehensive overview of the activities of the COE office.

The Office of the COE remained vigilant towards the risks and challenges stemming from the pandemic Covid-19 and in response all examinations were held as per standard guidelines. Valuation of answer scripts were done by External for UG students. Both external and internal valuation is done for PG students. COE office takes the earnest efforts in the interest of the students and remains committed to extend all kinds of support to students.

## **2. Initiative Drive:**

Several initiatives were launched as the situation of Covid-19 pandemic required continuous focussed attention. More changes have occurred around new guidelines relating to conducting examinations based on UGC Academic reforms in Higher Education Institutions, Outcome based education and Bloom's Taxonomy was implemented. The Departments framed their programme outcomes and course outcomes in tandem with the Institutional outcomes and the same are approved in the respective Board of Studies meeting. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) organised orientation programmes for faculty members to measure the PO's / CO's. Internal valuation and end semester examinations are structured around the attainment of the PO / CO.
