My blessings to our students. I feel it proud to present the Annual Report for the Academic Year 2018-19.

In the current Academic Year 1245 students which includes 1077 in Graduate Courses and 168 in Post-Graduate Courses are receiving Value-Based Education with 58 teaching faculty and 34 non-teaching staff. I am happy to bring to attention that most of our students are from rural areas whose parents are small and marginal farmers and down trodden members of the society which includes SC, ST, BC and Minority communities. The state and central government have dispersed scholarships to the tune of Rs.1,05,03,640/- in the current Academic Year. In the current Academic Year 1188 have applied for scholarships. Still 29 students from Degree College have to get scholarship. Our students were getting financial support from various charitable organizations and philanthropist as well.

UGC SUPPORTED DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES

University Grants Commission (UGC) has sanctioned Rs.60,00,000/- for the construction of Outdoor Stadium. Rs.30,00,000/- in 1st phase and Rs.24,00,000/- in 2nd phase have been released by UGC so far and the Siddhartha Academy also sponsored 24,00,000/-.

EXAMS WING

Mr. M.VenuGopal, as Controller of Examinations, Mr.N.V.Srinivasa rao and Mr.K.Ramesh as Additional Controller of Examinations are discharging their duties with lot of responsibility.

It is the seventh year since we got autonomous status for our college, and we have applied for Autonomous Status Extension on 21st December, 2017. The autonomous peer team has visited our college during 3rd and 4th of August, 2018 and sanctioned Autonomy status for another 5 years.

In the first semester examinations held in October, 2018 we achieved a pass percentage of 53% in first semester, 62% in third semester and 73% in fifth semester.

The IV Semester examinations held in the month of March-2018 and the results of final year students are as follows:
