1. Aims of the Research Policy

- The Research Policy was discussed and accepted in the Academic Council 2014- 15 meeting.
- 2. The research policy of the college aims to create and support a research culture among its teachers, staff and students and for enriching and enhancing the professional competence for developing and promoting scientific temper and research aptitudes, for realizing the 'vision' and 'mission' of the institution and for contributing to national development.
- It also aims at ensuring that the research activities of the college conform to all applicable
 rules and regulations as well as to the established standards and norms relating to staff
 and ethical conduct of research.

2. Scope of the Research Policy

This policy shall apply to all the scholars of the college undertaking research and for the purpose of this policy 'researchers' are defined to include

- All staff, temporary and permanent, who are active in teaching, research, administration and provision of any form of support to the core functions of the college;
- > All students studying in the college;
- All mentors, guides, external experts and sponsors associated with any of the research activities of the college

This policy will apply to all the research and related activities of the institution and activities will include

- Knowledge compilation and communication initiatives for keeping abreast of academic developments such as writing of textbooks or chapters, monographs; developing/updating curriculum, etc.
- Creative activities involving the generation of new innovative ideas, hypotheses, images, performances, including design in any field of knowledge which leads to the development of new knowledge, understanding or expertise;

- > Research projects of students and scholars undertaken as part of the curriculum or proposals for enriching it
- Publications, presentations and communication of the research outcomes and related activities.

3. RESEARCH OBJECTIVES (AUTONOMOUS)

This research policy provides a broad framework to guide scholarly research with the following objectives:

- To create and promote a culture of research among the faculty and students of A.G &S.G Siddhartha degree college of arts and science (Autonomous).
- To identify research areas and specify research topics of academic, practical and socially relevant significance
- To organize seminars/conferences/workshops on research topics and training programmes in research methodology and various areas.
- 4. To ensure quality, integrity and ethics in research.
- To publish research papers in appropriate journals and to make available such published information to the end users.
- To facilitate the publication of reports submitted by the faculty and students.
- To give incentives to faculty for the publication of papers.
- To bring about an annual/periodic compendium of abstracts/papers presented by the staff and students in various seminars / conferences / workshops.
- To create awareness in the society through various research initiatives and by giving due publicity to the socially useful research projects that will be undertaken by the college.
- To establish Research Center in different disciplines with emphasis on socially relevant topics.
- 11. To encourage faculty members to publish research papers, undertake various research projects of social and academic importance and to give incentives to faculty for the publication of papers.

Research Policy implementation mechanism


The college shall have a well-defined research quality which shall act as a guideline for the scholar, teachers and all other concerned personnel.





INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHT CELL

IPR POLICY AND FEATURES

IPR describes about registered design, covering patents, copyright, layout design and trademarks, trade secrets, integrated circuits, anti-competitive practices and geographical indicators in contractual licenses.

The Intellectual Property (IPR) could be achieved in the following forms:

- 1. Patent
- 2. Industrial design
- 3. Trademark
- Copyright In the form of plans, specifications, guidelines, graphics, training materials, software programs, records, drawings, instruction guides, student materials, new techniques, algorithms, concepts of confidential Information, Technical knowhow, Mask works, Process.

About the Intellectual Property: IP is an intangible knowledge and shall mean and include—all results, conclusions, deductions, inventions, ideas, improvements, discoveries, enhancements, solutions, processes, modifications, know-how, data and information of every kind and description conceived, generated, made, or reduced to practice as the case may be, designs, software programmes, genetically engineered microorganisms, business models and copyrightable work- resulting from the intellectual output of the faculty, staff, students, research scholars and other employees of the Institute. IP is, thus, an outcome of the Institute supported research or sponsored research, industrial consulting or other forms of joint research and development work. Although, a patent application accompanied with provisional application does not confer any legal rights to the applicants, it is, however, a very important document to establish the earliest ownership of an invention.

- Exceptions for Patent: However, inventions claiming substances intended for use; or capable of being used, as food or as medicine of drug or relating to substances prepared or produced by chemical processes (including alloys, optical glass, semiconductors and inter-metallic compounds) are not patentable.
- 2. Whether Patent can be revoked: As it is conferred by the state, it can be revoked by the state, it can be revoked by the state in certain cases even after grant, and whether or not it has been in the meantime sold or licensed.
- 3. Contest / Conflict with sponsoring agency: Where the sponsoring agency is not forthcoming for filing joint IPR application, the Institute, at its discretion, may file the

- application with the absolute ownership and will meet the entire cost of securing and protection of IPR. Copyright: Patent seeks to protect the applied and extension research, the law of copyright seeks to protect pure or basic research.
- 4. If the intellectual property is an outcome of joint research undertaken by the Institute personnel with external organizations /agencies/individuals, the IP will be owned jointly by the Institute and the collaborators. In case of joint ownership, the Institute will offer the first right to commercially exploit the joint IP, whether or not the same has been formally protected by patent(s).
- IP Counselling: IPR cell will counsel and interact with inventors of potential intellectual products and assist the Institute in identifying the IPR potentials.

IPR Cell

- In case the Cell recommends for filing of patents, the Convener, IPR Cell will process
 the application through one of the approved attorneys from the panel maintained at the
 IPR Cell.
- 2. If any copyrightable work is produced during the course of any sponsored /or collaborative activity, the ownership of copyright will be determined either according to the terms and conditions (related to IP) specified in the contract, if any, governing such activity or through mutual consultations and agreement with the sponsoring/collaborating agency.
- 3. Services from the Cell can be availed by
- a. All the faculty members, and students of A.G & S.G College, has set in place, systems and mechanisms to structure the process of commercial exploitation of the knowledge generated at A.G & S.G College under the provisions of IPR regime in the country.
- b. Services provided by the IPR Cell: The cell provides knowledge regarding a new substance or compound or yield Obtained from any field or lab can avail the commercial place for sales under trade name or brand name of particular place or goods with IPR.


