"Basmati" is long grain aromatic rice grown for many centuries in a specific geographical area, in the Himalayan foothills of the Indian sub-continent, blessed with characteristics of extralong slender grains that elongate at least twice their original size with a characteristics soft and fluffy texture upon cooking, delicious taste, superior aroma and distinct flavor, Basmati rice is unique among other aromatic long-grain rice varieties.

Black rice

Black rice, also known as purple rice or forbidden rice, is a range of rice types of the species Oryza sativa, some of which are glutinous rice. There are several varieties of black rice available today.

Mapillai Samba Rice:

Navara Kizhi is also used in Ayurveda for treatment of polio, psoriasus, rheumatism, diabetes, snake bite, peptic ulcer, emaciation of limbs, lifestyle maladies while the porridge of Navara grains in milk is prescribed as special food for invalids and infants. Rosewood

Rose wood is a timeless choice for hand-carved furniture. It is brownish-red and carries a premium quality. They have slow growth and usually grow to a height of 60 ft.

Mahogany Wood

Mahogany trees grow and flourish in warm climates. They grow up to the height of 150ft. Mahogany wood has a reddish-brown tint that beautifully darkens with time and has a straight fine even grain pattern. Mahogany wood furniture very durable.

Acacia Wood
